Incidents of note

- Sadly, there was a road traffic collision which fatally injured a
 pedestrian walking along Sheppey Way, Iwade in the early
 hours of Saturday 3rd February. This is an ongoing
 investigation and so not too much can be disclosed presently.
 However, if anyone has any information regarding this
 incident, please can they call 101 and quote Kent police
 incident KP-20240203-0110. This was a section of road of
 which is national speed limit.
- There were three calls over 15th and 16th January whereby there were reports of someone knocking a door in Sheerstone and then acting suspiciously around Iwade school. When he knocked the door, he claimed to the home owner to be cutting down trees on behalf of the Council. On the 16th, following a call from the school, this male was located, and full details obtained. The male was able to prove that he was a tree surgeon. There were no offences disclosed and so his details have been processed and submitted for intelligence. If there are any further similar type calls, please inform me.
